Each toddler walking through the gates of School of Knowledge is viewed as a talent reserve and the school works relentlessly towards empowering each and every child.

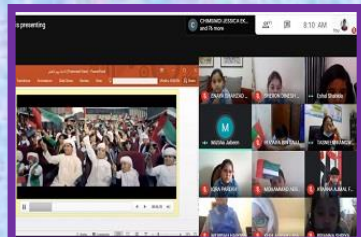
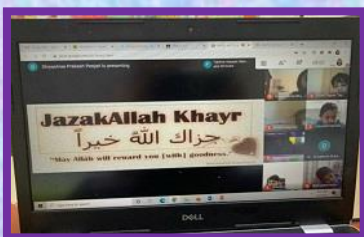
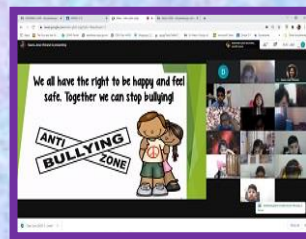
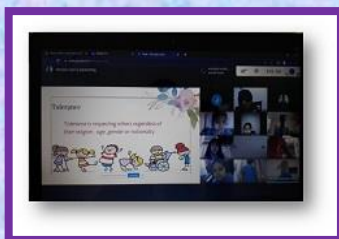


POSITIVE PASSIONATE & PERSISTENT

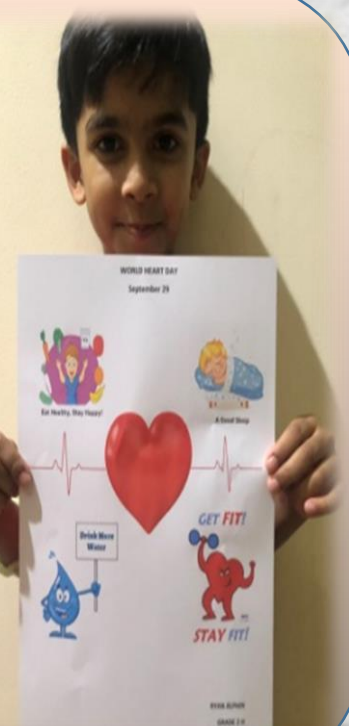

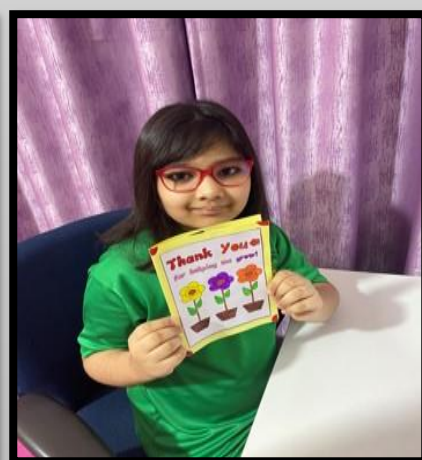
World Heart Day

World Mental Health Day

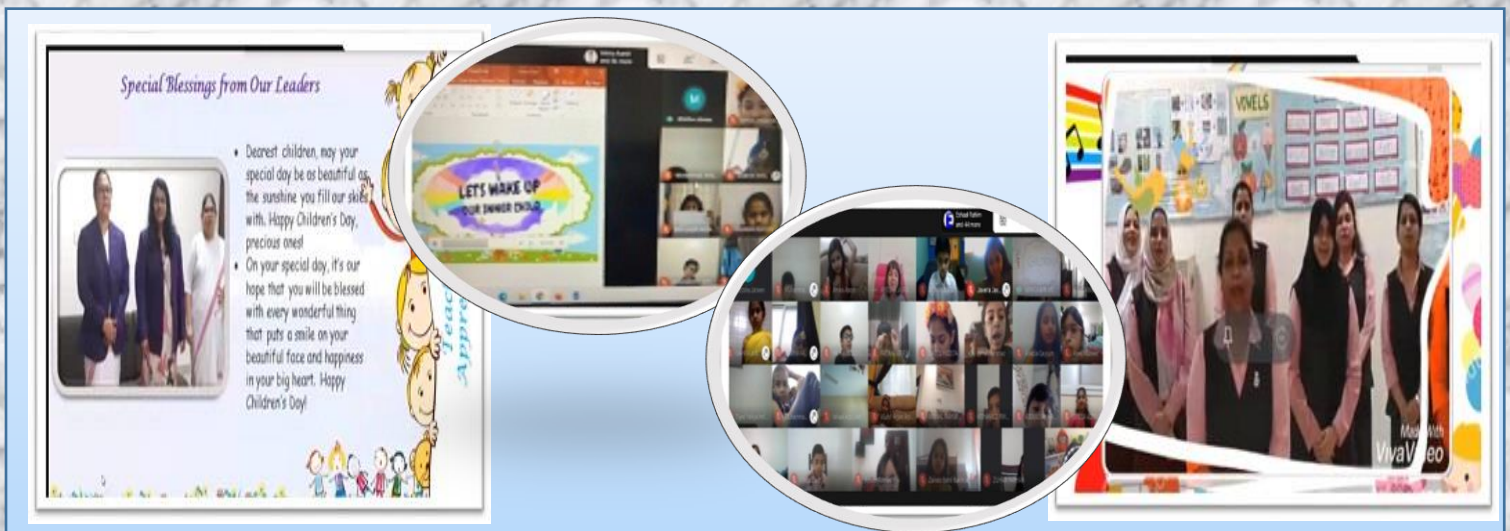

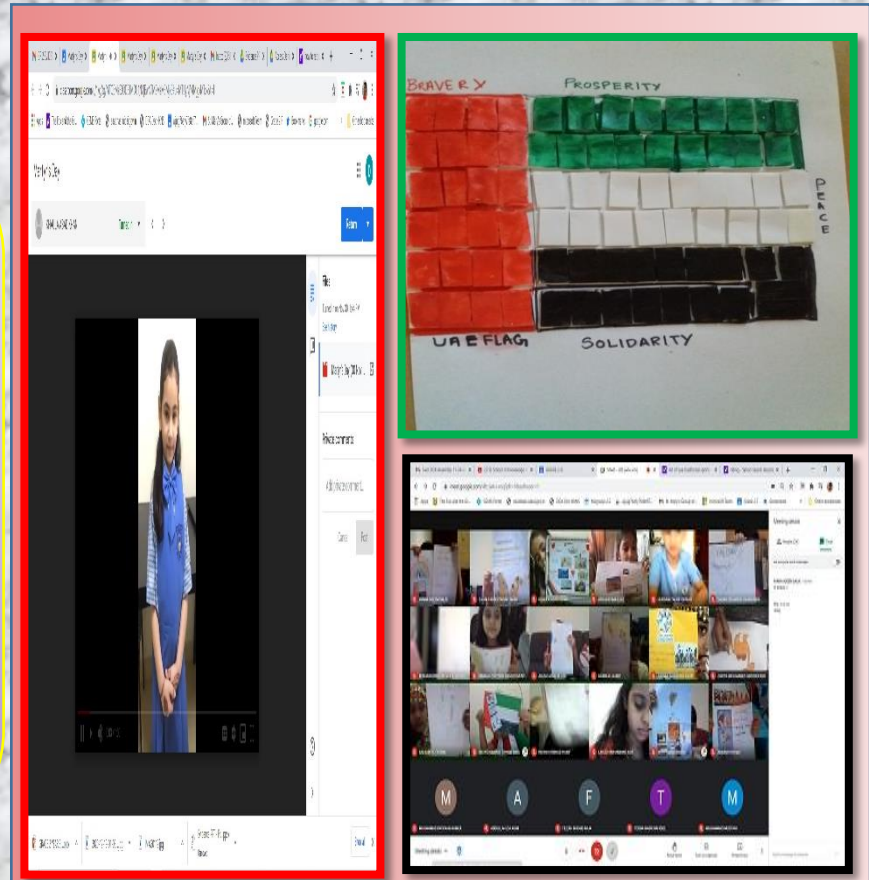


Flag Day

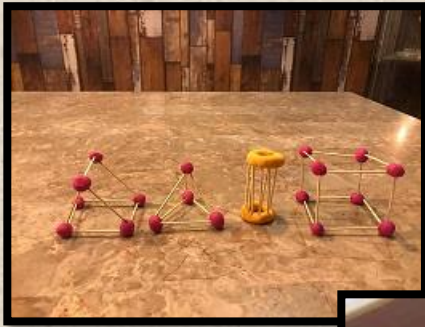


National Day of UAE
