
'Coming together is a beginning, keeping together is progress, working together is success'.


#### From the Vice - Principal's Desk...


I enjoyed participating in the Read Aloud competition that was held in the School Auditorium. I read the story from my reading file. I used my expressions to read the story fluently.






















## Math Race – 17/10/2022 TO 20/10/2022

A competition was held among the students of each class and the students who took the least time to finish all the three levels were the winners.























