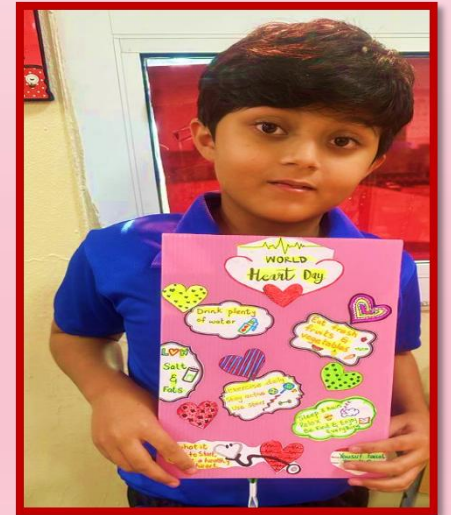


WORLD HEART DAY 29-09-2023

05-10-2023

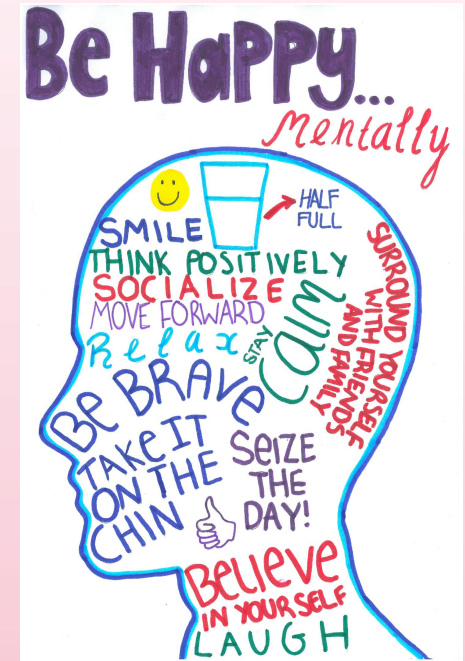

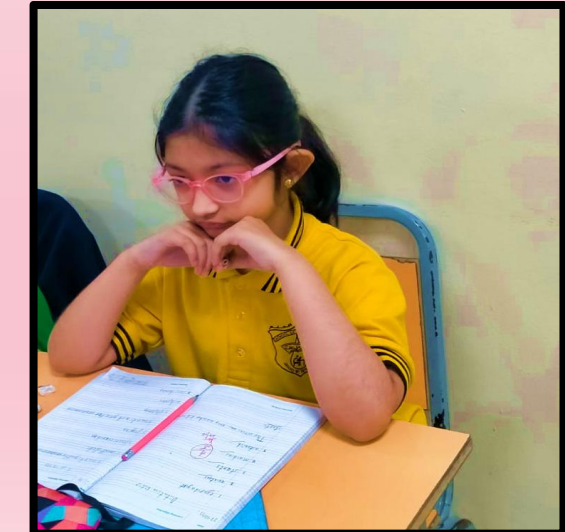
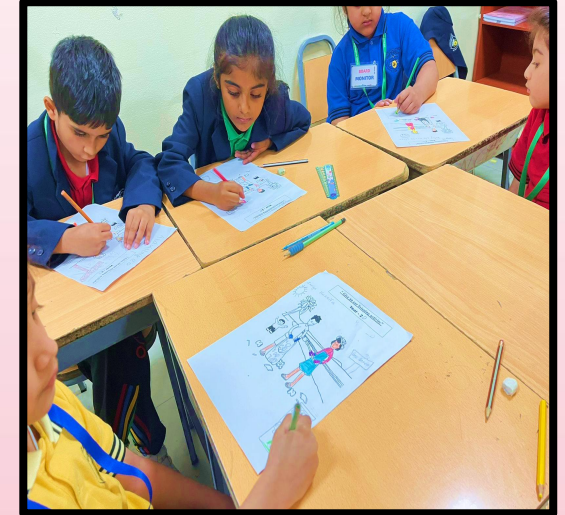
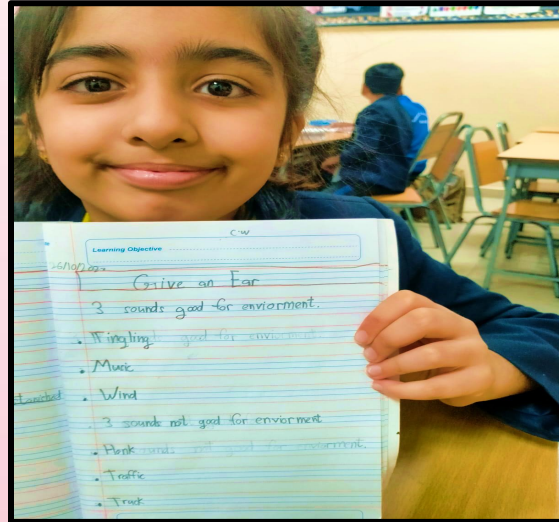


LISTEN UP: UNLOCKING THE POWER OF ACTIVE LISTENING! GIVE AN EAR

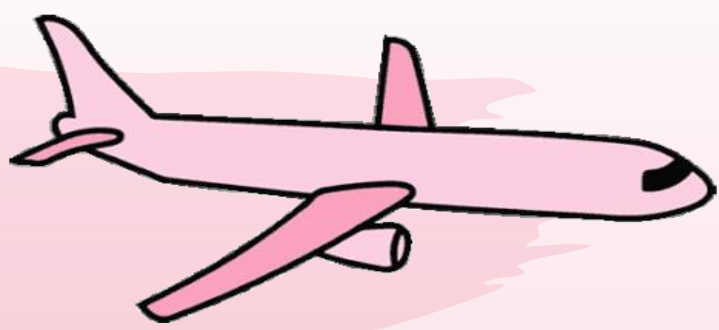

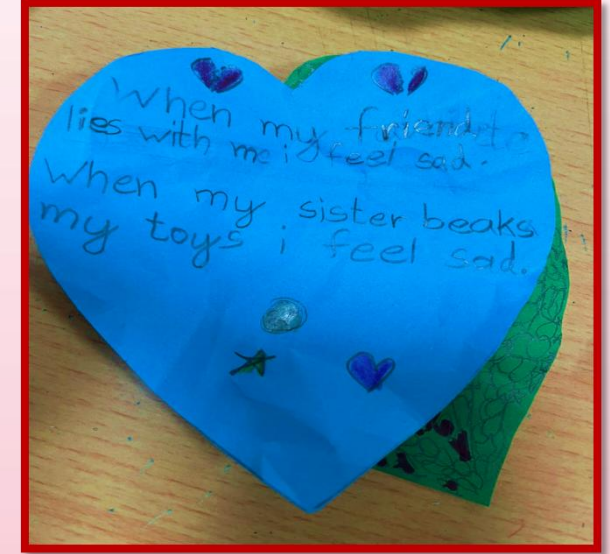


ANTI-BULLYING DAY 16TH NOVEMBER 2023

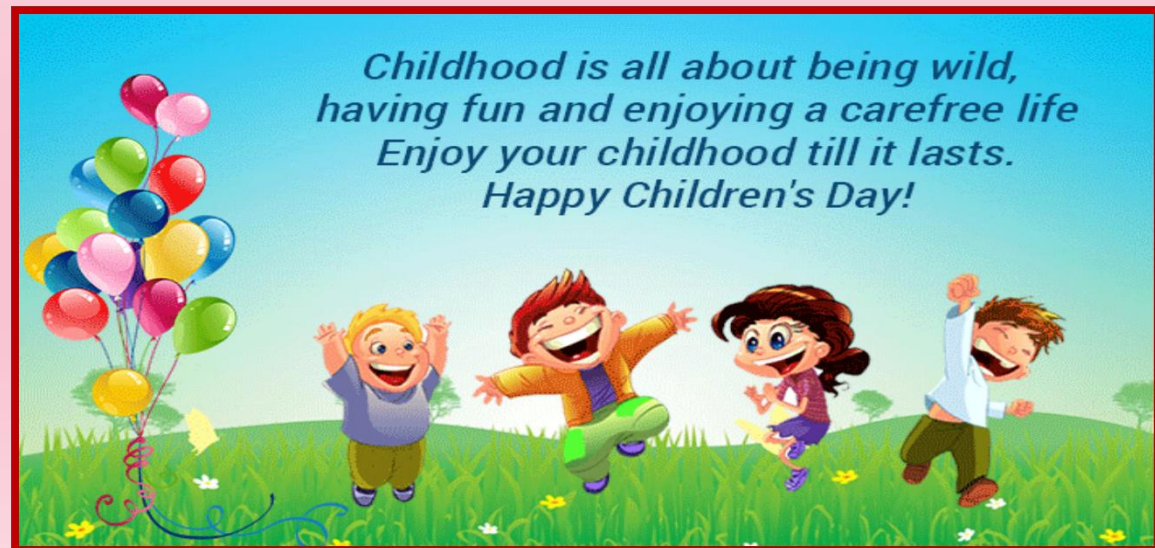

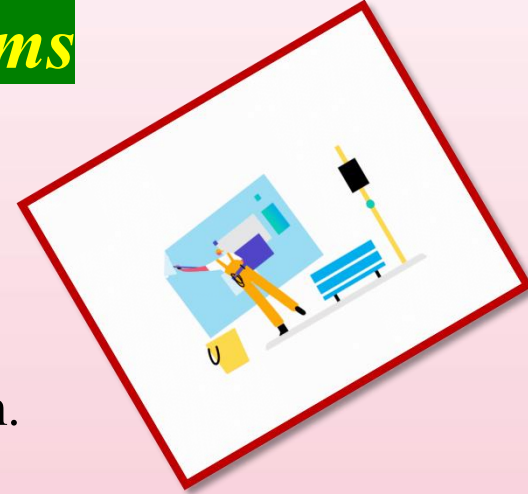
