Guiding Lights - A Parent's Perspective on Nurturing Tomorrow's Leaders"

'A JOURNEY FROM 'SCHOOL OF KNOWLEDGE' TO 'SCHOOL OF WISDOM'

We all are intelligent parents because we enrolled our child to one of the topmost schools in the UAE – School of Knowledge. But how many of us have the wisdom to realise that a child's real development happens at home?

Wisdom is confused with knowledge. Knowledge is the information and understanding of a subject, but wisdom is the ability to make correct judgement and decisions. The source of knowledge is learning/education whereas the source of wisdom is personal experience and expertise. At its core, wisdom is an ability to take the knowledge you have and translate it into good decisions, discerning what is right and wrong. The good news is that wisdom is not reserved for old age. Even with their limited life experiences, children can demonstrate wisdom when they put good sense into action, find solutions to conflicts or weigh their options and arrive at a logical conclusion.

As parents how can we foster wisdom and good decision making in our kids?

- 1} *Lead by example:* Most of the values are ‘caught and not taught’. If children see us weighing our options before making a crucial decision or we share with them our process for arriving at a particular conclusion, they will see wisdom operating in real time.
- 2} *Allow natural consequences to play out:* Watching our child struggle or make a poor choice is one of the hardest parts of parenting. However its important to allow our children to make mistakes.
- 3} *Stay involved with our child and their learning:* Children grow up and change everyday but the more we talk and stay connected the easier it will be to identify their strengths/ interests and help them to develop a long-term view of the future.
- 4} *Stay aware of their friend group:* No matter our age, we tend to become like the company we keep. Our child’s world revolves around their social interactions so as parents we can help our child process the attributes they are looking for in a friend, so they can make a wise decision.

While knowledge and critical thinking skills can certainly be taught in a classroom setting, wisdom is often thought to be gained through life experiences. Hence, as parents we play a significant role in planting the seeds of wisdom and impart a holistic education that will help our children to navigate the complexities of life with grace and purpose. But do not confuse experience with expertise. Our children having faced a problem does not guarantee that they have mastered the solution. Also do not mistake expertise for wisdom. Having deep knowledge does not guarantee that you know when it applies.

Let us strive to cultivate a generation of learners who not only excel academically but also embody values and wisdom, contributing positively to the world and living lives of purpose, fulfilment, and significance.
