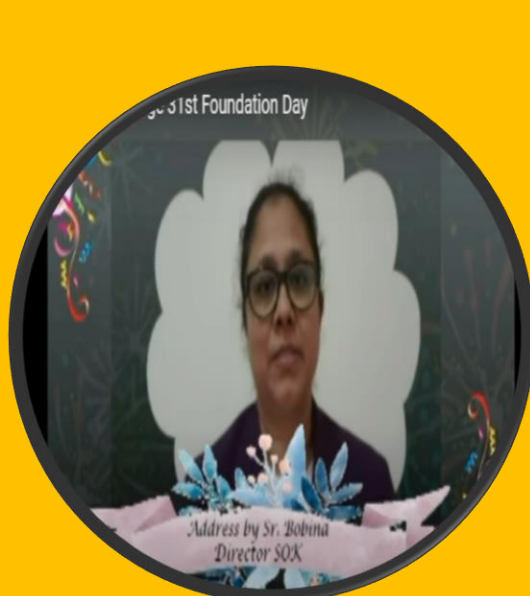


*The Foundation Day at School of Knowledge was celebrated on 9th September with enthusiasm, fun and frolic.*

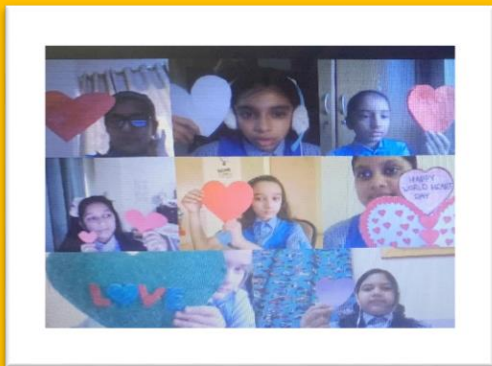
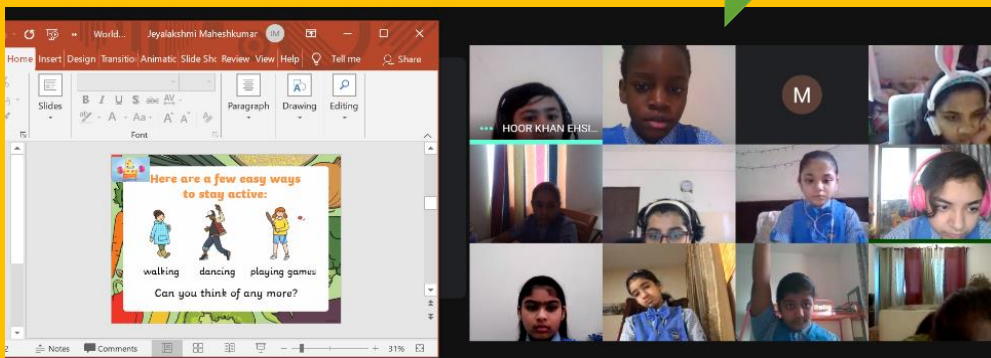

#### Online Quiz



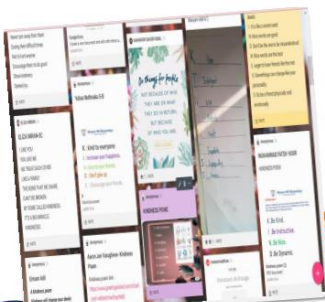
The online quiz was adopted from the counsellor's guide for Cyber Bullying prevention by SPEA.

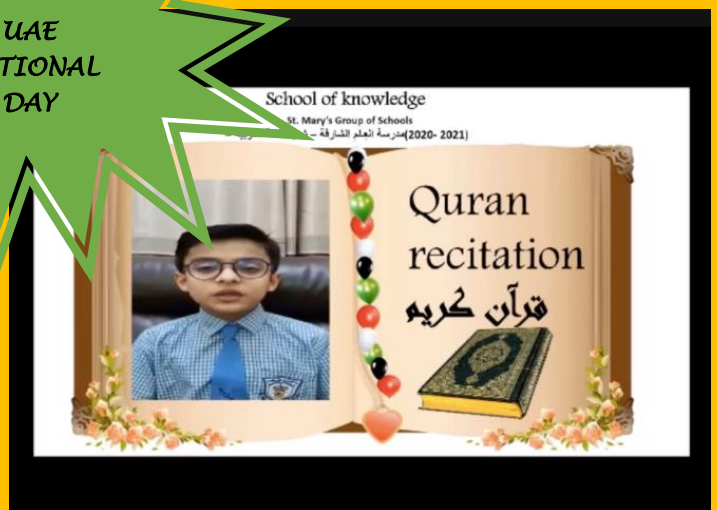
## UAE NATIONAL DAY CELEBRATION

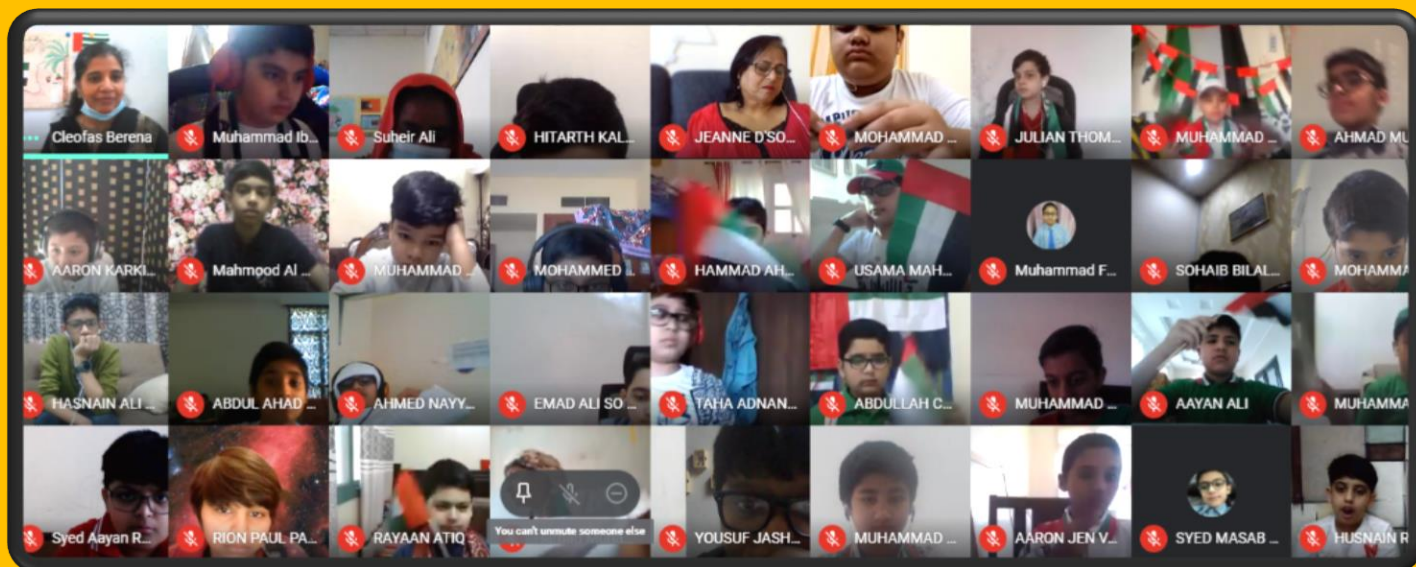
November 25<sup>th</sup>, 2020

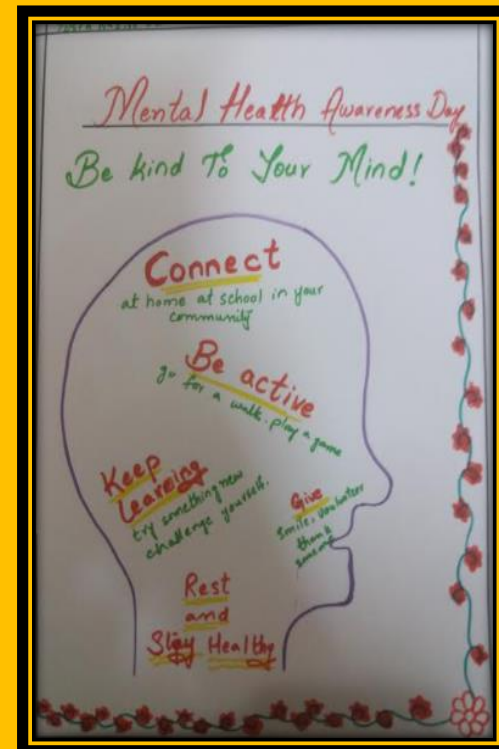
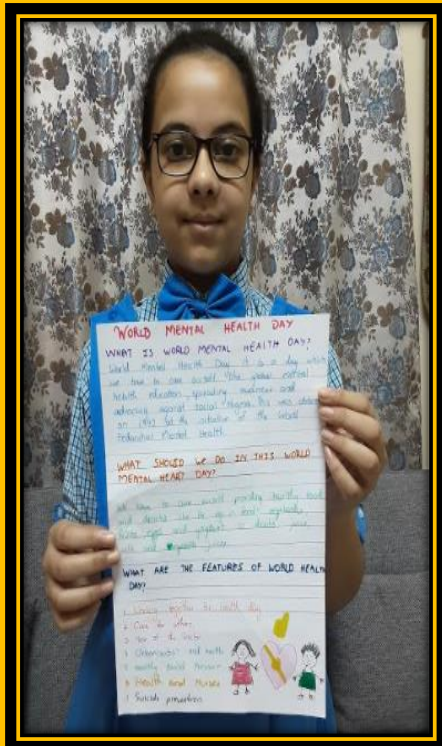
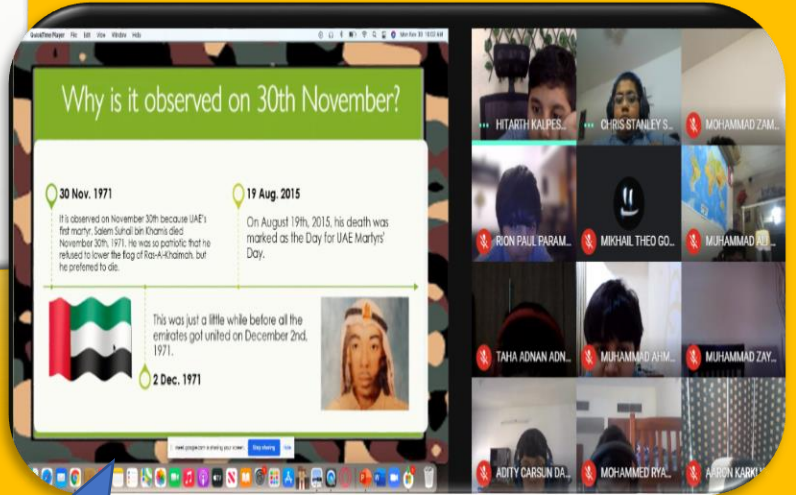
## MARTYRS' DAY

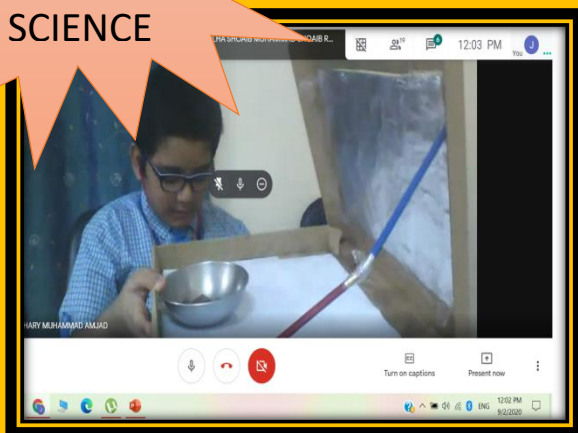

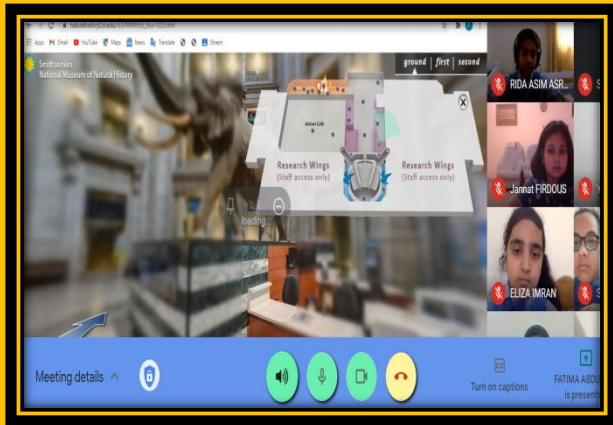

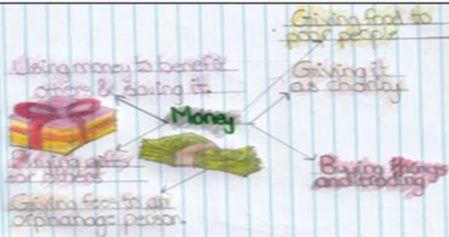
Active learning activities help promote higher order thinking skills such as application of knowledge, analysis, and synthesis

Active learning activities engage students in deep rather than surface learning, and enable students to apply and transfer knowledge better



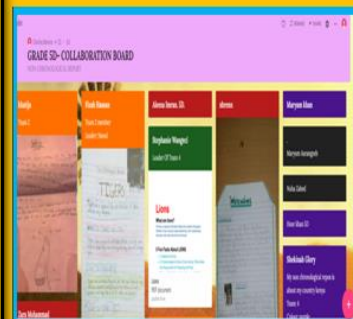

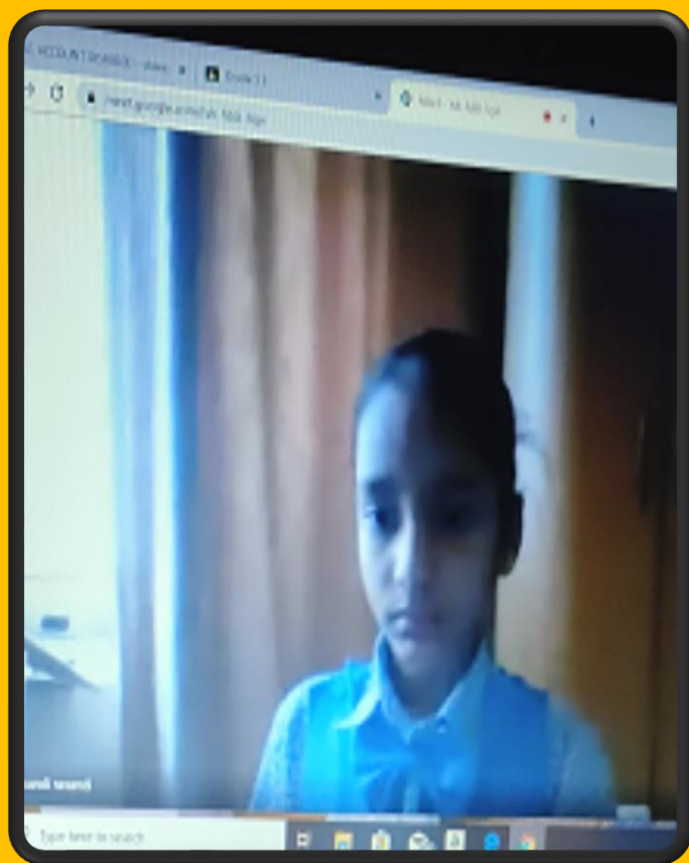
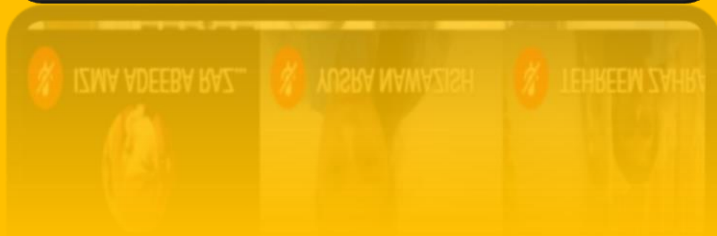
