




The Foundation Day at School of Knowledge was celebrated on 9th September with enthusiasm, fun and frolic.





Health & Hygiene week started with a special assembly, followed by various activities during the week.






Health refers to the healthy state of mind and body physically fit to have no disorder, illness or disease.


