

WORLD HEART DAY




Year 6 and 7 boys celebrated the event by giving awareness on World Heart Day on 29th September 2022.

Students expressed their feeling of gratitude towards teachers by reading out heartfelt quotes and poems in addition to heart-warming gratitude cards.





‘Make Mental Health and Well-Being for All a Global Priority’.


At SOK, in line with school Vision and Mission, we work relentlessly towards the wellbeing of each and every child.



Global Hand Washing Day- 5th October 2022



Listening
Activity



Listening involves the identification of the difference among sounds. This identification and discrimination leads children to the understanding that sounds are grouped together to form words. When we teach listening, we allow students to follow directions, understand expectations, and make sense of oral communication. Listening like reading, is an active process. Listening and reading requires the use of a similar thought process.

External Assessment - NGRT – 14th -17th November




