


The Eighth Edition





THE SCOUTS AND GUIDES CLOSING CEREMONY

Creating a balloon lamplight can be a fun and creative DIY project! Here are general steps you can follow to make one:

Materials Needed: Balloon, String lights

Craft glue or mod podge, Paintbrush, Newspaper or old magazines, threads and Scissors

Steps:

This project allows for a lot of creativity, so feel free to experiment with different shapes, sizes, and decorations to make your balloon lamplight unique!

- 1.Inflate balloon to desired size.
- 2.Mix craft glue or mod podge with water in a bowl.
- 3.Use paintbrush to apply glue mixture to balloon.
- 4. Tear newspaper/magazine into strips./or take threads
- 5. Apply strips to balloon, overlapping and smoothing with glue.
- 6.Allow balloon and paper layers to dry completely.
- 7.Pop and remove balloon to leave a paper shell.
- 8.Insert LED string lights through opening of paper shell.
- 9. Customize with paint or additional paper layers.
- 10.Place and turn on for a cozy lamplight effect.
- 11. This streamlined guide should help you create your balloon lamplight effectively!
