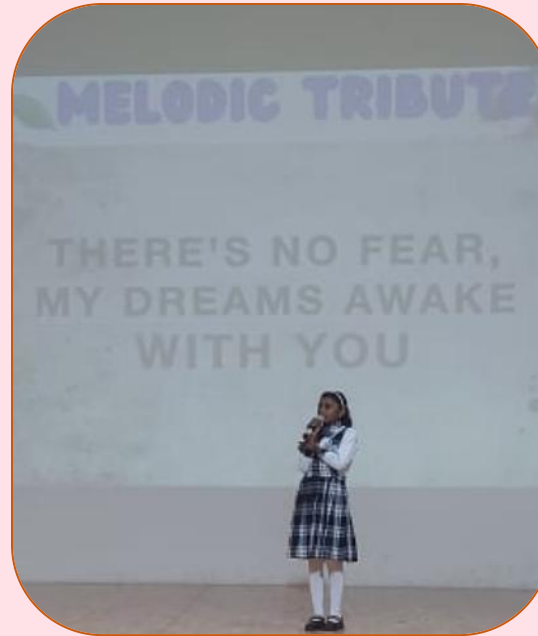

FS1 – World Earth Day

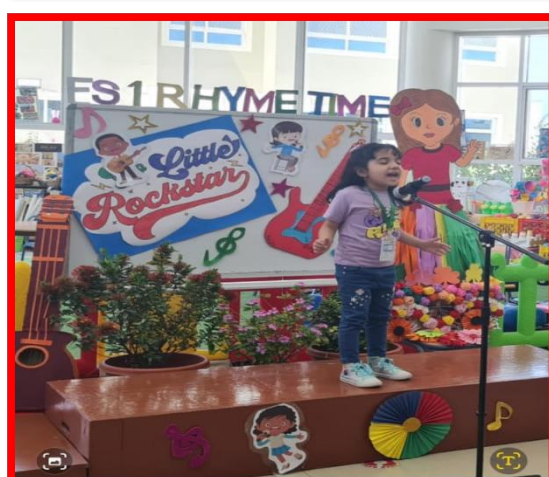

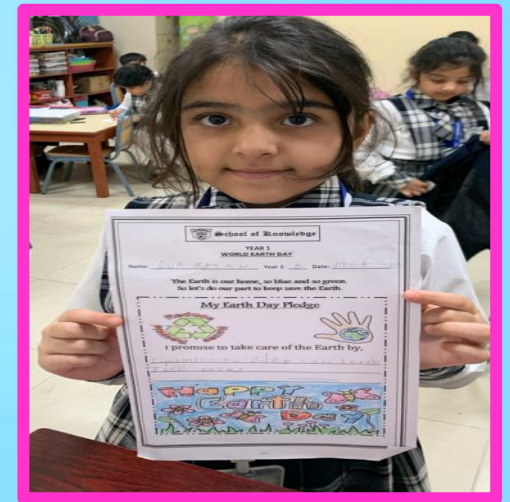
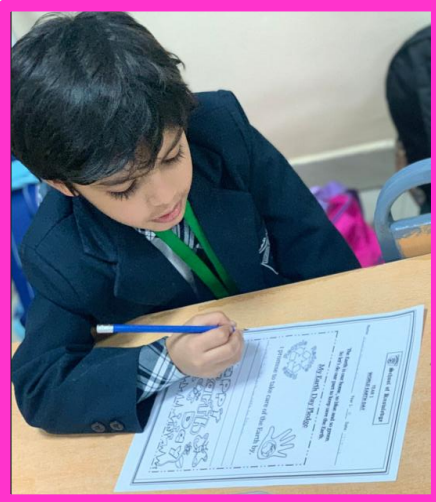
Year1 World Earth Day "Little Costumes, Big Messages!"

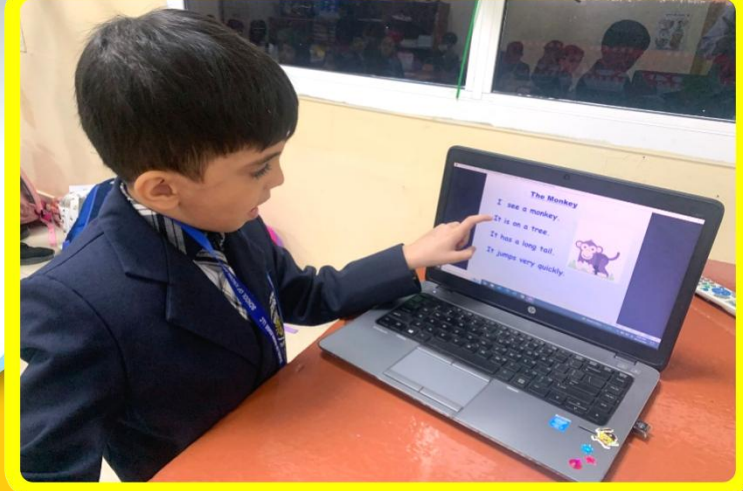

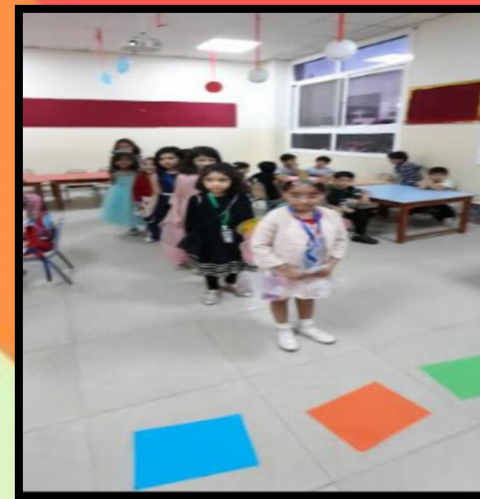
