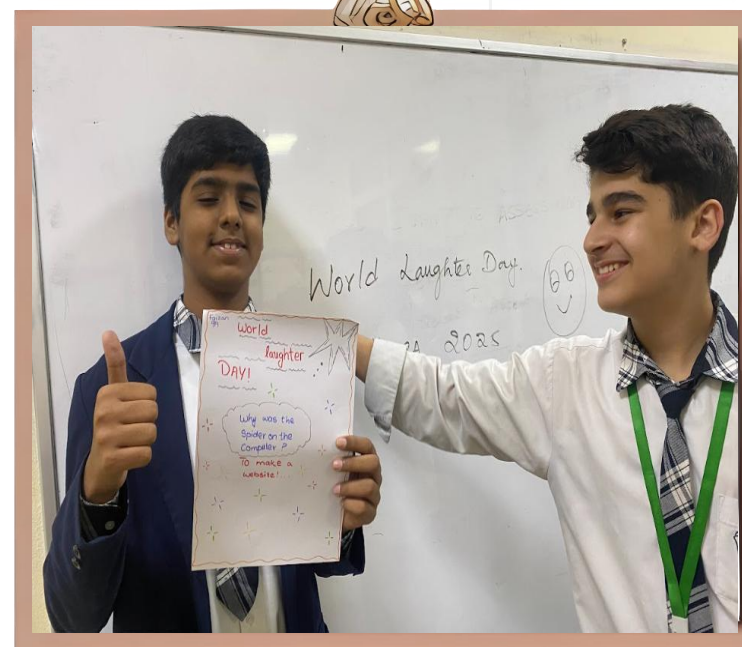
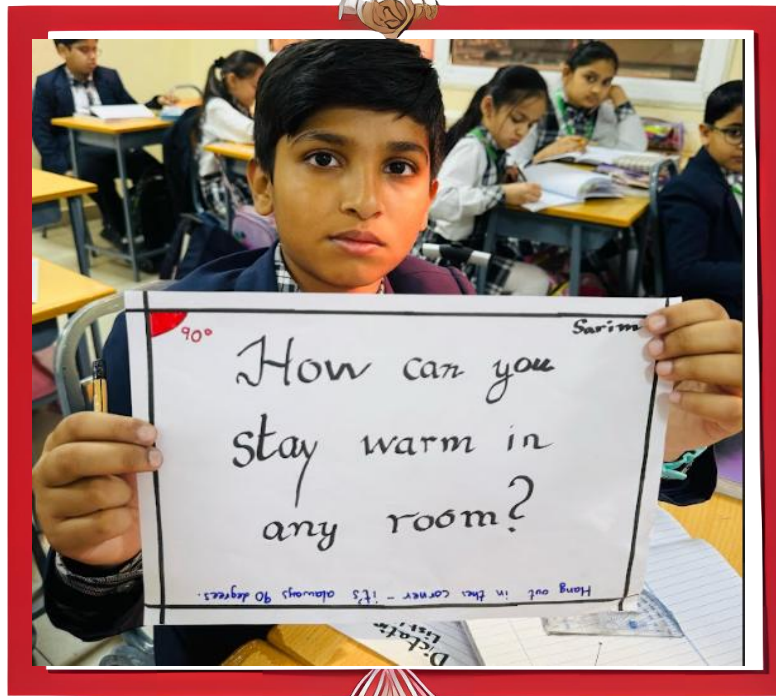
WORLD LAUGHTER DAY
